### **Detectives Investigating After Human Remains Found in Avondale Field**

**Pueblo, CO:** The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office continues an investigation after human remains were found Sunday morning in a field in the Avondale area of Eastern Pueblo County.

Sheriff's deputies responded at about 11:15 a.m. to a field in the 3500 block of 36<sup>th</sup> Lane after the property owner reported what he believed were human bones on the property. After it was determined the remains were that of a human, detectives were called out and took over the investigation.

Detectives are working to determine what may have led to the death and how the individual ended up in the field. Further information regarding the gender, identity and manner and cause of death will be released by the Pueblo County Coroner's Office pending autopsy results.

There is no indication that there is a threat to the public at this time. Additional information will be released when it becomes available.
